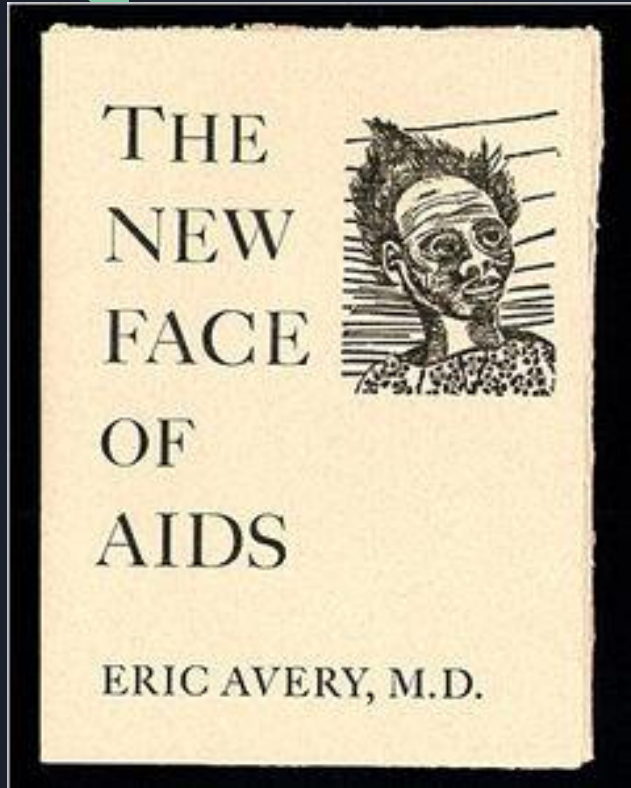

# Dr. Eric Avery



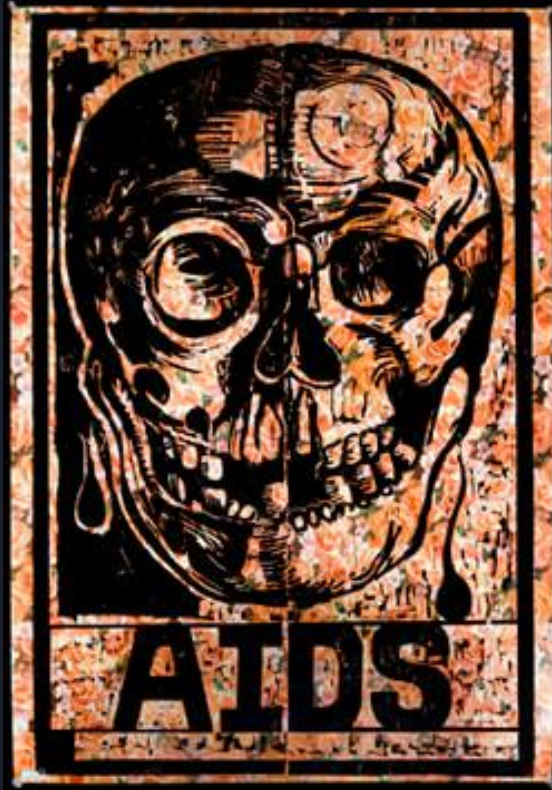
- Artist-doctor, received medical degree from University of Texas then completed his psychiatry work in New York
  - Worked as a physician during the Vietnam War
- How did he get to art?
- He left his medical career throughout his life to focus on his art career

- Most notably, he created prints concerning the AIDS/HIV epidemic during the 1990s while he still worked in the medical field

# Kara Walker

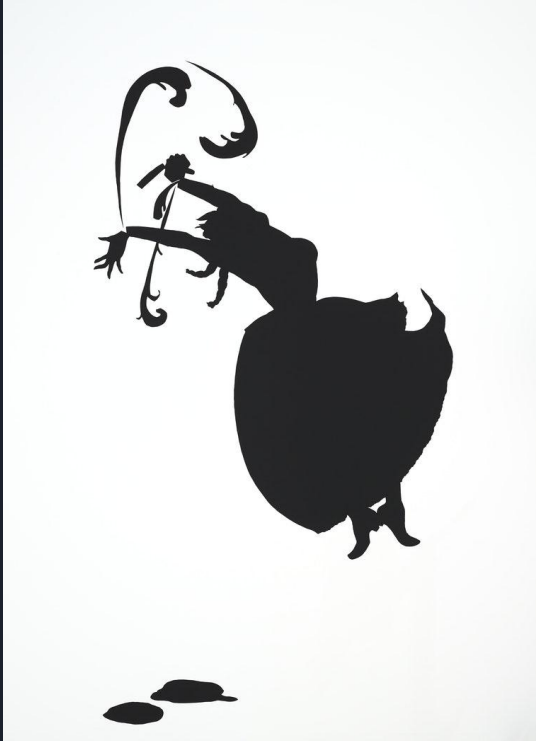


-Famously known for her gigantic silhouettes
